What you need to bring ~**

**Basics:**

- Sleeping bag, OR sheets, light blanket for bunk bed [single]
- Pillow
- Clothing [for one week]
- Hygiene products
- Special items

**Clothing:**

- Informal/casual/play-type clothing appropriate for warm days and cool nights to last a week
- Athletic shoes/walking shoes, something comfortable
- NO flip-flops or sandals [No Open-toed shoes]
- Underwear, socks, etc., for one week
- Light jacket or sweatshirt
- Sunday best or period clothing [optional] for Friday night dance and banquet

**Hygiene:**

- Towel/wash cloth
- Toiletries/ soap, shampoo, deodorant, etc.
- Brush and/or comb; Tooth brush/paste
- Vision products

**Special items:**

- Bible
- Medications/ Sun block/ Insect repellent
- Head cover for outdoor activities
- Non-amplified musical instrument [ You will have an opportunity to play acoustic instruments, period instruments, harmonica, etc.]

This year we will offer OPTIONAL outdoor tent camping. Tents will be provided. You may want to bring a cot to sleep on. If you are not allergic to insect repellent, you may want to consider bringing your own personal brand [check with your parents]. We will provide citronella type products working in the general camping area. Boys and girls will be in separate areas.

Please be sure and indicate on your Camper form if you are tent camping and how many guests you will have for the Friday Night Ball & Banquet.

The other Campers are just your friends you haven't met....yet.

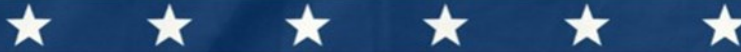

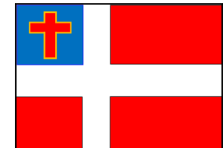
